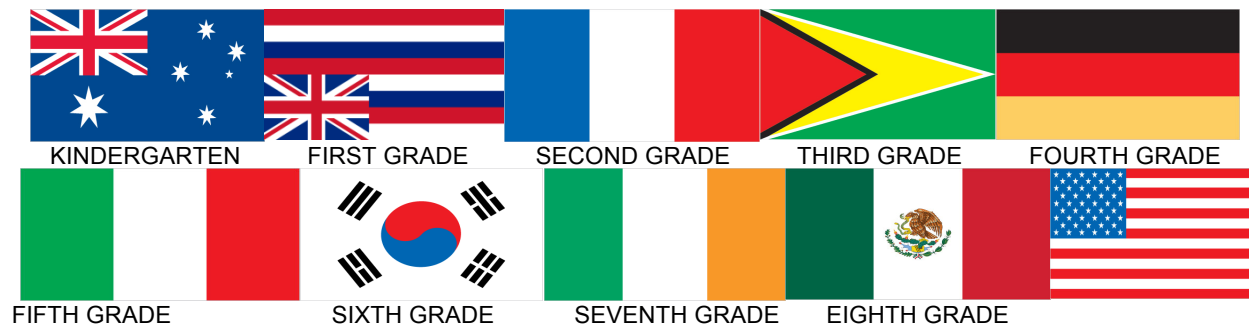


# SAINT MARGARET MARY SCHOOL
