## Last Week's News

Last week, the children received a 'three day weekend' due to **National Martin Luther King Day**. Teachers took the time out of their busy curriculum schedules to teach about this Civil Rights hero who dedicated his life so that all American citizens can live freely and equally. On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, our 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students took their 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter **Finals exams**. The purpose of these tests is to make a final review of the topics covered and assessment of each student's knowledge of the subject. Congratulations JR. HIGH STUDENTS for a job well done! On Friday, our 5<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders took their annual **ACRE TESTS**. The ACRE test is administered to students in 5th and 8th grade. The acronym stands for **Assessment** of Catechesis/Religious Education. This test is published by the NCEA (National Catholic Educational Association) and is an assessment based on the Catechism of the Catholic Church and the most recent catechetical documents. The test is quite important to our staff because the results are used to evaluate the effectiveness of a religion program. Next month our faculty will meet to discuss the results.

## Week Ahead News

Next week- **Monday** (JANUARY 24<sup>TH</sup>) is a half day. Our faculty and staff will gather together to discuss a variety of school issues. The purpose of the meeting is to discuss day-to-day school activities. Things such as school trip dates, school calendar changes, dress regulations, and behavior problems will be on the top of our agenda tomorrow.

On **Tuesday**, our children will begin their third round of **STAR TESTING**. STAR assessments provide teachers the most valid, reliable, actionable data of their students. On **Thursday**, report cards will be go home in the Family Folder. While it's true that we typically pass out Family Folders on Wednesday, this week we will distribute folders on Thursday so that we may enclose report cards.
