- 1. <u>Shoes</u> No sandals or 'flip-flops' allowed. Tennis shoes must be worn with socks. Socks must be worn and above the ankle.
- 2. <u>Shorts or skirts</u> shorts and skirts must be appropriate in length. Shorts and skirts may not be shorter than 2" above the knee. Baggy and oversized shorts may not be worn. All shorts and skirts may not have rips, tears or holes.
- 3. <u>Hair</u> may not be dyed

- 4. No purses or back packs allowed
- 5. No electronic devices.
- 6. Hats and sunscreen may be worn
- 7. No 'bag lunches' allowed. Children must bring money for lunch, snacks and souvenirs.

Please know that Friday, the day after our Knott's Berry Farm event, is a school holiday. No school or daycare on that day (May 22nd) or the following Monday (May 25th).
